# How to register with your local Help to Buy agent

As outlined in our eligibility criteria, we require proof of application and approval from your local Help to Buy Agent, a Registered Provider. You must apply to ensure that you are deemed eligible to use the scheme and can maintain the home ownership. This is an initial assessment.

A Help to Buy agent is a point of contact for you and everything shared ownership, including notifications for new developments in your area. The Help to Buy Agents are split into 3 across England.

This guide will detail the process and steps required to submit an application to your local Help to Buy agent. Once approved, proof of approval along with your application must be sent to the team taking care of your purchase.


At this stage you will need to declare if you have any persons that will be living at your Home Reach property and/or contributing to the payments including mortgage.

This applies for all adults (over 18) and children. For each adult that will be making a financial contribution, their details will need to be supplied.




# **Step 5**Current accommodation

You will be asked to supply information on your current living situation in section 4. Dependent on your current accommodation set up, further questions may appear for clarification. For example, if you have a landlord, their details will be requested.




# **Step 6**Employment details

You will be required to provide information on your current employment status at the time of your application. The same as section 4, dependent on your answer, further questions may appear to gain further insight such as premises and length of employment. This section also covers if you are currently or have previously been in the armed forces.




## **Step 7**Financial details

Step 7 captures all areas of your finances that will be accounted for, including your current income, any credits you may receive, your savings/deposit and any debts. Some of the information is listed as an optional addition.




# **Step 8**Equal opportunities

The equal opportunities section looks at your background, culture and circumstances. All answers on this section are optional or you can select a refusal to provide the information if you would prefer to not supply these details.




## **Step 9**More information

This step provides you with the opportunity to select how you heard about the scheme and provide any further information that you feel may be relevant to your application.



## **Step 10**Declaration

The declaration page details how your data will be used and stored in line with the data protection laws. You are also informed that references may be requested to ensure the safety of public funds. By ticking the box on this page you will be stating that you have read and agree to the declaration.


The first section of the application asks for details on the type of application that you will be making. This includes whether it is a joint or single application. The further stage focuses on your financial history with some yes or no questions


### Your details

# **Step 6**Your housing needs




### Employment and income

As well as this you will also be required to detail your income and any outgoings including loans and repayments.


# **Step 6**About you
